CQ and give grid, go up in multiples of 5. Beacon on lower frequencies- Beacons let you hear where frequencies are opening up. Sporadic E has no impact with sunspots. VHF Contest is June 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup>. Dennis talked to Japan on 6 meters. When 10 meters is going bad. 6 meters is usually better. Talked about moon bounce.
